

The Belt and Road China Hunan International Chess Open will be held in Tongguanyao town, Changsha city, Hunan Province China from 28th July(arrival) to 7th August(departure) 2019.

There will be three open tournaments (A, B and C) according to the rating of the participants.

Tournament A: rated higher than 2400(including 2400)

Players distribution in tournament A, B, C will consider their FIDE rating of 1st July 2019.

Prize will not be shared if players have same points. If case of a tie for the prize, the tiebreak system will be used. Women players can get regular prize and special prizes at the same time.

All prizes are before the local tax.

Time control

Time control for Tournament A, B and C: 9 rounds Swiss system, 90 minutes for the whole games with an increment of 30 seconds for each move from the first.

Tiebreak system

For tournament A and B:

- 1. The average rating of the opponents minus the lowest rating
- 2. The points of opponents except 1 highest and 1 lowest Opponent
- 3. The points of opponents
- 4. More number of victories

For tournament C:

- 1. The points of the opponents minus the highest and the lowest
- 2. The points of the opponents
- 3. Sonne-born berger
- 4. More number of victories

Note: If case of a tie for the prize, the above mentioned rules will be adopted. If still a tie, then players will play a blitz game. White has 6 minutes and black 5 minutes. After 60 moves 2 seconds will be added to each move. Black wins if a draw. If there are more than 2 tied players, the match system will be decided on site by the chief arbiter.

Special Prizes

There will be special prizes for juniors in age 17-18(born between 2001/1/1 to 2002/12/31), age 15-16(born between 2003/1/1 to 2004/12/31), age 13-14(born between 2005/1/1 to 2006/12/31), age 11-12(born between 2007/1/1 to 2008/12/31), age 9-10(born between 2009/1/1 to 2011/12/31), age under 8(born after 2011/1/1). Only 1^{st} prize will be awarded for 100 US dollars.

Special prize for two players who play for the game with most time. Each player will be awarded for 100 US dollars.

Lucky prizes for 8 players whose badge number will be chosen randomly during awarding ceremony. The 1st prize for 3 players is chess board. The 2nd prize for 5 players is 100 US dollars for each.

No entry will be accepted after 2019.7.5. Payment has been paid for are not refundable.

Male player rated 2650 or above and female player rated 2450 or above are without entry fee and will be provided free accommodation with three meals in a twin-room basis. Male player rated 2750 and women world champion will be provided free accommodation in a single room with three meals.

The room prices includes three meals and is per person per day.

The organizing committee will purchase accidental insurance for players in tournament A and B. The insurance fee of 2 US dollars will be paid by players. Players in tournament C should purchase accidental insurance and keep the receipt during the tournament.

Players who need transfer to the official hotel from Changsha Huanghua International airport will pay for 15 US dollars to the organizing committee.

Bank details

Only after the organizer receive the payment, the rooms will be arranged. Bank commission fee should be paid by the payers.
